Requirements:

At least 19 years old, U.S citizen, no felony convictions, no misdemeanor convictions of moral character violations, G.E.D. or high school diploma, valid Florida driver's license, be able to successfully pass a physical, psychological, urine test, and extensive background, pass criminal history check, no more than 3 moving infractions with in 3 years, must be fingerprinted, and reside within 30 miles of the police station. Successful completion of a Florida CJSTC Academy required

Benefits:

Salary: **\$34,125** per year based on hours; (\$32,500/year base)

Equipment: Uniforms, Glock 40 cal., soft body armor, duty gear

Vacation and Sick leave: 8 hours/month of each

Holiday leave: 10 days

Personal Holiday: one 12 hour day (taken before end of year)

Units: K-9, Criminal Investigations, Traffic Unit, Patrol

Salary Incentive: \$30 for AA degree/month; \$80 for B.A. degree/month; up to \$130.00/month max.

City Retirement: age 55 or 25 years; 12% per year of salary in investment account vested at 100 % at 6 years

PBA Contract: covered by union negotiation

Health Insurance: Paid by city if individual coverage; reduced family and spouse coverage
