



### **RISK ASSESSMENT**


### NONE-LOW-MODERATE-MEDIUM- HIGH-EXTREME-DANGEROUS

The aforementioned assessment of moderate-medium is based on an overall assessment of risk factors to include past events similar in nature, expected crowd and traffic concerns. The event location/venue is suitable to accommodate a large crowd of people to include the blocked streets around the court house street.

The event will also be contained within the perimeter of the courthouse and the designated/blocked streets to include:

- >N. Adams street (blocked from Jefferson street north to King street (No Through Traffic)
- >N. Madison street(blocked from Jefferson street north to King street. (No Through Traffic)
- >Washington street( between Monroe and Love street) (No Through Traffic)
- >Franklin street (between Monroe and Love street) (No Through Traffic)

Not impeding the normal flow of traffic on King street and Jefferson street and with proper accessibility for response of Law Enforcement and Emergency Personnel if necessary



The event will be policed by GCSO Deputies and personnel with an emphasis on event location crowd control, high visibility and area contained/blocked street.

All Law Enforcement functions and assignments will remain flexible throughout the duration of the event.




